



IMMEDIATE STAFF OPPORTUNITY: FAMILY WORKER

Primary Job Responsibilities:

- Manage intake referrals
 - Coordinate inquiries and screen prospective teen girls
 - Meet the prospective teen girl and her family in the home for initial interviews
- Case Management for teen girls, in collaboration with the Program Manager
- Family Work
 - Build relationships with parents and supporting ministries and keep them connected to their teen girl
 - Organize visits to teen girl's home
 - Facilitate parent-child conferences for each teen girl before and after each home visit
- Record a summary of all follow-up contacts with teen girl graduates and ex-teen girl residents
- Maintain teen girl clerical records, in compliance to DHS
- Fulfill other job-related responsibilities as delegated by the Program Manager

Experience, Education, and Qualifications:

1. Experience in residential ministry
2. Experience in working with and discipling troubled teen girls
3. Agree to an initial two-year commitment
4. Has raised a family or is in process of raising a family
5. Commitment to the vision, mission and core values of Camp Andrews and Meadows of Hope
6. At least an associate's degree (at least 60 credit hours) and three years' work experience with families and children (preferred, but not required)
